Terms of Office start in January following the November elections. Dates next to officials' names indicate the year of the next election for that office.

Register to Vote

To vote you must register unless you are in military service or are a veteran hospitalized outside of your county of residence.

To Register You Must:

- Be a citizen of the United States for at least one month before the next election
- Be a resident of Pennsylvania and your election district for at least 30 days before the next election
 - Be 18 years of age on the day of the next election
- Not be confined in a penal institution for a conviction of a felony

Voter registration applications will be accepted if postmarked on or before the last day to register prior to a primary/election and received by the Registration commission within five (5) days.

You Must Re-Register If:

- You have changed your name, address, or wish to change party affiliation

HOW TO REGISTER

You may register in person at the Voter Registration Office (150 N. Queen St., Suite 117, Lancaster, PA 17603) or by using a Registration-by-Mail form available at the Registration Office, municipal buildings, party headquarters, libraries, and some post offices. Registration forms are available on www.co.lancaster.pa.us/elections. You may also register online at <http://register.votespa.com>; at any State/Federal agency or when you apply for a Driver's License. Pennsylvania has closed Primary Elections. This means you must be registered within a party to vote for the candidate of your choice in the Primary.

ABSENTEE VOTING

You may apply for an Absentee Ballot if you will not be in your municipality on Election Day due to working, business, illness, vacation, etc., and cannot visit your Polling Place during voting hours of 7a.m.-8p.m. Application forms are available on www.co.lancaster.pa.us/elections which you may complete and mail or can be obtained at the County Registration/Elections office located at 150 N. Queen St. where you may complete the application and vote at the same time. If persons have a disability or continuing illness, they may contact the Voter Registration/Elections office for information. The last day to apply is the Tuesday before the Election.

First-time voters and first-time voters in a new district must show identification at the polls. Photo ID is not required.
